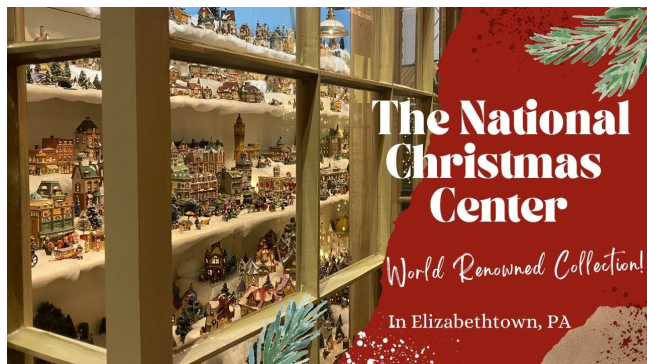

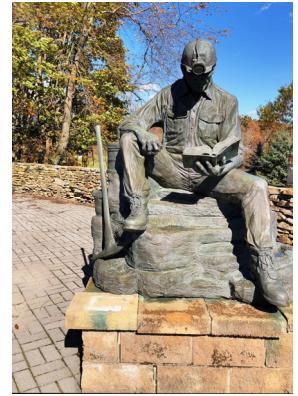
TOWER OF VOICES

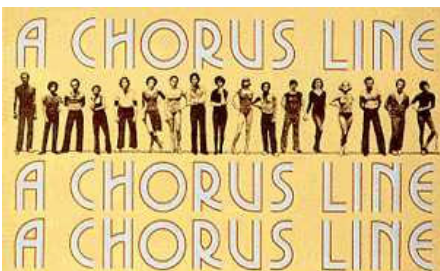
